- Most JYM students take a combination of JYM Courses and University courses. The courses above are JYM area studies courses. JYM area studies courses are electives taught at the JYM institute. They have been designed to bridge the transition from US-style to German-style university studies and include field trips and excursions.
- A typical student course schedule consists of a combination of JYM and LMU Munich courses. It is not recommended that students plan to take **all** their course work at the university unless their language skills are clearly at the B2 level. This is especially true for the natural sciences and business.
- All JYM students are directly enrolled at the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München (LMU Munich) and have access to the full university curriculum except medicine and law. [LMU Munich Courses](#)
